PARKING ALERT!

You are about to lose your free street parking to **PARKING METERS** – Please Help our community to limit the installation of meters.

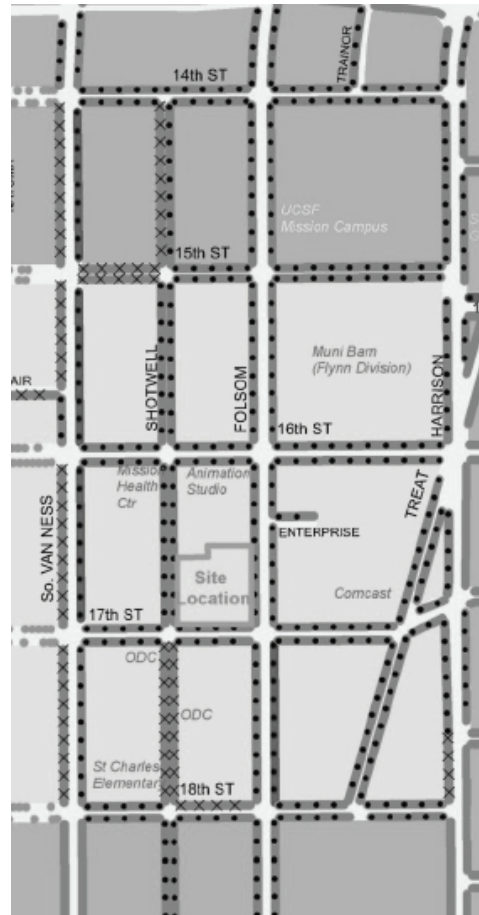
The proposed parking district will stretch from S. Van Ness to Harrison, and from 14th to 18th Streets (see map). Meters will operate 6 days a week, 9am to 6pm.

Our community agrees we need a solution to our current parking problem. But meters will mean that residents/employees will be forced to pay for street parking and will need to constantly manage the meters they are parked at or pay city fines. This will cost residents/ employees several hundred dollars a year and be a huge inconvenience.

The city's proposal will be implemented in early 2012, so we all need to get involved **NOW** and suggest alternative plans that include residential permit parking areas, along with suggestions for meters on some of the more business orientated streets.
