

Question: In no more than 100 words, please explain your positions on Prop. D and Prop. I and, if you wish, elaborate on any of your other positions.

Connie Chan's answer:

D: San Francisco's ballot process should be accessible to ordinary people, not just wealthy interests. Proposition D would quadruple the signatures required for voter initiatives, putting grassroots democracy out of reach for neighborhood groups, workers and community advocates.

I: I strongly support dedicated, long-term funding to build and preserve affordable housing. And we need reliable funding paired with a result-driven and adaptive housing strategy to build the most homes possible for working San Franciscans. But transfer-tax revenue can be volatile and difficult as a dependable funding source. This is why I support Proposition C which will provide stable, growing investment through the Housing Trust Fund.
